

Bleiblerville EEA Scholarship Guidelines

The Bleiblerville EEA has bake sales throughout the year to earn money for the club. This money is used for expenses during the year such as memorials, yearbooks, Coins for Friendship, Dollars for Scholars, Operation Christmas Child and Christmas bags.

Any remaining money, up to \$2,000 may be used for scholarships given to High School graduating seniors. Scholarships of up to \$500 will be given to those seniors who request consideration. First priority will be given to EEA members' children and grandchildren. Next, consideration will be given to seniors in the Bleiblerville area who are active in the 4-H program. If there are no requests from this group, then if funds are still available, great-grandchildren and other seniors in the Bleiblerville area will be considered. If there are not enough requests for scholarships, donations may be given to other worthwhile projects in the community.

A request for Scholarship Consideration should be presented to the club by the May meeting. Forms will be available at the Bellville High School Counselor's office. Scholarships will be distributed by September.
