

Lynette Winkelmann Scholarship Guidelines

1. Students are to be provided scholarship information through local newspapers and online through the BHS website.
2. Applications must be on file with the high school counselor by May 5, 2017.
3. Applications will be accepted for junior colleges, four-year colleges, and vocational trade schools. This scholarship also applies for those entering out-of-state colleges, universities, or vocation trade schools.
4. Applicants must be graduating seniors of Bellville High School and also have graduated from West End Elementary and completed at least one full year at West End.
5. A. This scholarship is limited to high school seniors
B. Monies must be utilized within two years from acceptance
6. \$500 will be awarded yearly, funds permitting, and will be given preferably as one scholarship.
7. Scholarship money is to be paid directly to the student after presentation of evidence that the student has been duly accepted. Reimbursement of \$500 will be given upon proof of registration.
8. Recipients will be chosen on scholarship, educational goals, community involvement, and need. First consideration will be given to those seeking a degree in education.
9. Applicants will be made by completing a personal data sheet and a brief paragraph on "Why I would like to receive this scholarship."
10. Applicants should have good academic standing. Honor courses will be noted.
11. Any applicant meeting the above requirements, regardless of social or economic level, race, color, sex, religion, national origin, or handicap may apply.
